In those cases we deploy PageGate at the PSAP/dispatch center and will use one or more of the integration modules to output the incident data to lamResponding in real-time.

We have numerous local installations of PageGate at dispatch centers around the world using features ranging from Command Line/ASCII, SNPP, SMTP, Serial and the Web API.

lamResponding also uses PageGate in our datacenters as well for the SNPP module. This allows a dispatch center to send SNPP direct to lamResponding if they have a native functionality or PageGate server onsite.
